CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Conditions of Entry

- The Auction Sale Selling Agents are **Grant, Daniel and Long** who will apply the normal selling commission to the sale, which the exhibitor/s agree to pay. The sale is to be held at Dalby/Wambo Saleyards on **Friday 9th October 2009, at 11:00am.**

Arrival Times

- All cattle should arrive at the Dalby Saleyards prior to 2pm on Thursday 8th October, to enable drafting by the agents. Curfew will be at 4pm.

Pre-sale Weighing

- Pre-Sale weighing will commence at 5pm on Thursday and the animals will be then placed in their allocated class pens. Weights, as outlined in the Class Schedule, will be strictly adhered to.

Judging

- Judging will commence at 6.30am on Friday morning.

Viewing

- All entries may be viewed by the public and trade, between 9am and 11am on Sale Day (Friday 9th October)

All cattle shown must be the property of the vendor for 60 days prior to Friday 9th October.

All entries must be polled, dehorned or well tipped. Vendors are required to supply all necessary declarations.

All animals should be ear tagged with the appropriate age tag, supplied by the Selling Agent prior to arrival at Saleyards.

Entry fees will be deducted from Account Sales after sale of cattle.

If any pen should be passed in at the Auction a penalty assessed on the passed in value amounting to Fat Cattle 2.5% will be payable to Grant, Daniel and Long.

Bull Credits are not transferable unless nominated.

All prize money will be awarded by the organizing committee. The organising committee have the right to change entries if required after weighing. Where insufficient entries are received in any class (2 entries or less are deemed insufficient), these entries will be included in the next higher weight range class.

Any tags which may identify the vendor or property should be removed

SPECIAL FEEDLOT CHALLENGE

For entries received from accredited feedlots (including client's cattle) there will be a competition scored on the basis of the feedlot's cattle being judged on 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings.

Points will be awarded as follows:

Single Classes

1 st	2 points	2 nd	1 point	3 rd	½ point

Eg. Feedlot who has 2 x 1st in the single classes, 2 x 2nd in the pen of 3, 2 x 3rd in the pen of 6 would receive:

<u>GRAIN FED CLASSES (Accredited or Non-Accredited) SINGLE STEER</u>	
Class 1 *	Single Steer or Heifer grain or grass crop fed, showing not more than 2 permanent incisors with a maximum live weight of 400kg. Suitable for Local and Supermarket Trade.
Class 2	Single Steer or Heifer, showing not more than 4 permanent incisors with a minimum live weight of 401kg and maximum of 540kg. Suitable for Supermarket, Hotel & Restaurant Trade.
Class 3	Single Steer, showing not more than 6 permanent incisors with a minimum live weight of 541kg. Suitable for Export Trade.
<u>GRASS/CROP FED CLASSES SINGLE STEER</u>	
Class 1 *	Single Steer or Heifer grain or grass crop fed, showing not more than 2 permanent incisors with a maximum live weight of 400kg. Suitable for Local and Supermarket Trade.
Class 4	Single Steer or Heifer, showing not more than 4 permanent incisors with a minimum live weight of 401kg and maximum of 540kg. Suitable for Supermarket, Hotel or Restaurant Trade.
Class 5	Single Steer, showing not more than 6 permanent incisors with a minimum live weight of 541kg. Suitable for Export Trade.
<u>GRAIN FED CLASSES (Accredited or Non-Accredited) PENS OF 3</u>	
Class 6 *	Pen of 3 – Steers or Heifers grain or grass crop fed, showing not more than 2 permanent incisors with a maximum live weight of 400kg. Suitable for Local and Restaurant Trade.
Class 7	Pen of 3 – Steers or Heifers, showing not more than 4 permanent incisors with a minimum live weight of 401kg and maximum of 540kg. Suitable for Supermarket, Hotel & Restaurant Trade.
Class 8	Pen of 3 – Steers or Heifers, showing not more than 6 permanent incisors with a minimum live weight of 541kg.
<u>GRASS/CROP FED CLASSES PENS OF 3</u>	
Class 6 *	Pen of 3 – Steers or Heifers grain or grass crop fed, showing not more than 2 permanent incisors with a maximum live weight of 400kg. Suitable for Local and Restaurant Trade.
Class 9	Pen of 3 - Steers or Heifers, showing not more than 4 permanent incisors with a minimum live weight of 401kg and a maximum of 540kg. Suitable for Supermarket, Hotel & Restaurant Trade
Class 10	Pen of 3 - Steers or Heifers, showing not more than 6 permanent incisors with a minimum live weight of 541kg.

<u>GRAIN FED CLASSES (Accredited or Non-Accredited) PENS OF 6</u>	
Class 11 *	Pen of 6 - Steers or Heifers, Grain or Grass Crop Fed, showing not more than 2 permanent incisors with a maximum live weight of 400kg. Suitable for Local & Restaurant Trade.
Class 12	Pen of 6 - Steers or Heifers, showing not more than 4 permanent incisors with a minimum live weight of 401kg and a maximum of 540kg. Suitable for Supermarket, Hotel & Restaurant Trade
Class 13	Pen of 6 - Steers or Heifers, showing not more than 6 permanent incisors with a minimum live weight of 541kg.
<u>GRASS/CROP FED CLASSES PENS OF 6</u>	
Class 11 *	Pen of 6 - Steers or Heifers, Grain or Grass Crop Fed, showing not more than 2 permanent incisors with a maximum live weight of 400kg. Suitable for Local & Restaurant Trade
Class 14	Pen of 6 – Steers or Heifers, showing not more than 4 permanent incisors with a minimum live weight of 401kg and a maximum of 540kg. Suitable for Supermarket, Hotel & Restaurant Trade
Class 15	Pen of 6 – Steers or Heifers, showing not more than 6 permanent incisors with a minimum live weight of 541kg.
<u>COWS PEN OF 8 MIN.</u>	
Class 16	Pen of 8 or more Cows. Suitable for Export Trade.
<u>FEEDER STEER & HEIFER PEN OF 10 MIN.</u>	
Class 17	Minimum Pen of 10 - Steers or Heifers, showing not more than 2 permanent incisors with a maximum live weight of 400kg. Suitable for Supermarket, Hotel and Restaurant Trade.
Class 18	Minimum Pen of 10 - Steers or Heifers, showing not more than 4 permanent incisors with a minimum live weight of 401kg and a maximum of 500kg. Suitable for Export Trade.
Class 19	Champion Pen of Heifers to be judged from Classes 6 through to Class 15
